If you are age 70 ½ years or older, this is a great way to minimize the tax bite associated with IRA required minimum distributions (RMDs).

 from your income for

 federal tax purposes.
- ✓ FOR EXAMPLE: A couple can transfer up to \$200,000 through the IRA charitable rollover each year. Each individual is limited to \$100,000 from his or her IRA.
